- The participation fee for non-Japan residents includes a transportation pass for moving between areas around the Kansai. The pass is not included in the participation fee for Japan residents, but can be purchased at the time of registration or later as an option. (limited quantities)
- Competitors may join up to 5 events of the 59 offered. From the sixth event on, an additional charge of 2,000 yen per event is required.
- Some events will require an extra fee.


